Terms and Conditions of Competition Prize Draw

3. In the event of any dispute regarding this draw, the decision of DBC shall be binding and final and no correspondence or discussion shall be entered into.
4. Qualifying entrants: entrants must satisfy the following conditions to enter this competition:
 - 4.1 Must have completed the Dacorum SurveyMonkey registration form.
 - 4.2 Must be a primary school within Dacorum borough.
 - 4.3 Must agree that, should they win the competition, they consent to taking part in publicity around the prize (point 10). This publicity will include the creation of a short video of the prize being used by the school's students, along with supporting photos and a written quote and/or article written by staff and/or students about how they have engaged with the prize. DBC would have permission to use this publicity on all of their own communication channels in the future – including our website, social media, newsletters and magazines. The school would have full responsibility for ensuring that the suitable permissions are in place for any students that are used in publicity shots. The competition will close at midnight on Thursday 20 May 2021, after which one eligible entrant will be selected by the Environmental Services Team at Dacorum Borough Council using a random computer-generated process and the selected entrant will be deemed to be the winner. The winner, will be notified via email and publicised on both the Dacorum webpage and social media channels.

DBC cannot accept responsibility for any error, omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operation, communications line failure, theft, destruction, alteration of, or unauthorised access to entries, or entries lost or delayed whether or not arising during operation as a result of a technical fault (including but not limited to computer hardware or software failure, satellite, network or server failure, server functions, viruses or bugs) or any other causes outside of its control.

14. DBC reserves the right to use the names of the entrant schools and participating staff and students in any publicity. Staff and students will be entitled to remain anonymous if they wish, but must state this to DBC whilst planning the publicity (as per 4.3).

15. These terms and conditions shall be governed by English law and all entrants submit to the jurisdiction of the English courts.
